KANSAS CITY — Nearly 250 exhibits will be featured at the 15th National Agricultural Career Show and Hall of States as part of the 53rd National Convention of the Future Farmers of America. George Verzagt, career show coordinator, said the number of exhibitors has more than quadrupled since the show moved from the Municipal Auditorium to the one and one-third acre H. Roe Bartle Exhibition Hall three years ago. "Agribusiness, federal

agencies, professional institutions will give the 20,000 FFA members and advisors attending the convention a chance to learn about career opportunities in agriculture," he said. "There will be a wide diversity of exhibits so there's sure to be at least one career displayed that will interest each person. Four groups will be honored for exhibiting all 15 years of the show's existence. They are the National Vocational Agricultural Teacher's Association, American Fisheries Society, American Society of Nurserymen, and the Farm and Industrial Equipment Institute.
