

# Reading Fair resumes with beef, sheep, dairy shows

READING — After a year of absence, the Reading Fair was once again brought to life, continuing a tradition lasting 125 years when the first fair was held.

The new fair, held last week behind the Reading Fairgrounds Market, and Fairgrounds Square Mall was a refreshing return to the "basics". Offering a variety of traditional Pennsylvania Dutch foods including a pig roast, the Fair shyed away from the commercialism of midways. In its place were events such as egg tossing and bale throwing, in which any fairgoer was welcome to compete.

Other attractions included a new and antique farm equipment, pony and carriage rides, and of course, livestock shows and exhibits, results for which follow.
