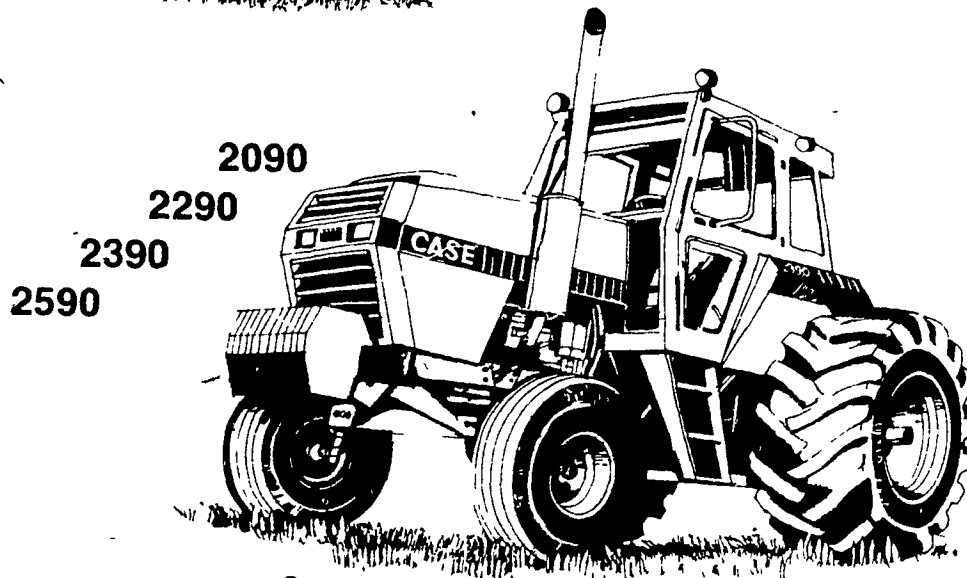

Order plants early

MEDIA — Are you planning to start a new planting of strawberries, brambles or blueberries next year? If so, it's best to get your plant order in early, advises James J. Keehen Delaware County Extension Agricultural Agent.

Ordering early assures a wide selection of varieties. Prime quality stock will be used to fill your order and ordering early may also mean that you will receive the plants at the most desirable time to plant.

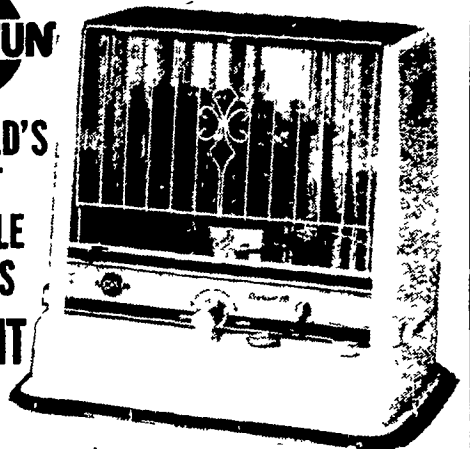
The best time to plant strawberries, brambles and blueberries in Pennsylvania is in April and early May

when the soil has dried out enough to be suitable for cultivation.

Remember that blueberries require cross-pollination to assure good crops. So choose at least two, or preferably three, varieties (only one plant of each is enough). Strawberry and bramble yields also are improved by cross-pollination but it's not absolutely essential. The planting should include varieties with early, mid, and late-bearing habit to extend the fruiting season over the longest period of time.
