Representing the club at the Dairy Council will be: Gretchen Kuehn, Karen

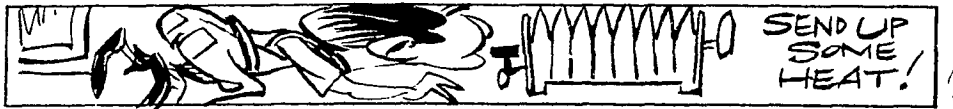
