"I am convinced that this project will prove beneficial to the farmer-members of Agri-Mark and Agway. It could open further possibilities for other farmers in the Northeast in adapting the concept to their own needs and economic goals," he stated.

Steele stressed that northeastern agriculture will remain strong, and that the family farm will maintain its vitality.

"We have become a part of a new world food system," he stated.

"The soybean, the kernel of corn, and the grain of wheat will become more important symbols of prosperity in the future than a barrel of crude oil," he continued

'Just as a good farmer regularly checks the tilth of his soil, so we must continually check the tilth of our cooperative to insure it is meeting the needs of our members, and the public, in years to come," he concluded
