Policy resolutions concern subjects ranging from toxic waste disposal, and on-farm alcohol production to brucellosis indemnity and dairy promotions.

Voting delegates will also elect the PFA president to a two year term.

In addition to business, those attending the convention will hear from a number of guest speakers and will participate in special events. Scheduled speakers include Penn-

sylvania Agriculture Secretary Penrose Hallowell, former U.S. Agriculture Secretary Earl Butz and American Farm Bureau Federation administrative secretary John Datt

Special events will include presentation of the PFA Distinguished Service Award and annual reports by PFA President Eugene Thompson of Indiana County and PFA Administrative

Secretary Richard Newpher. Outstanding county association program achievements will be honored during an awards banquet.

Other events will include conferences on Marketing, Commodity Futures, farm business organization and a Women's Conference.
