

New potato marketing council meets

HARRISBURG — The first meeting of the Pennsylvania Potato Marketing Advisory Council was held last Friday in the Agriculture Building in Harrisburg.

The council was created

by Pennsylvania Secretary of Agriculture Penrose Hallowell to assist state potato growers in dealing with problems associated with the growing and marketing of their products.

According to Hallowell,

the 15-member council will be made up of representatives from all sectors of the potato sector.

The meeting's agenda included a discussion of the upcoming review referendum for the state potato research program.

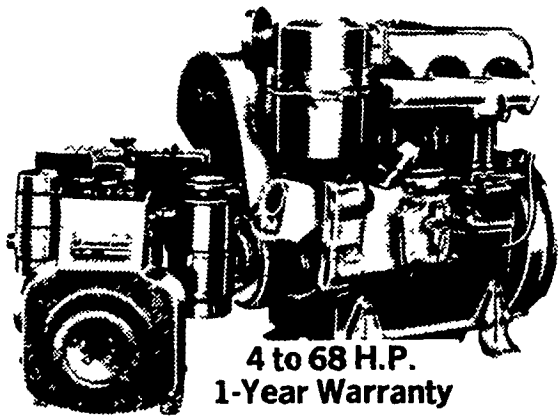
