EPA to hold sewer meeting in Leola

LEOLA — A public meeting will be held on November 17, 1980 in Leola to discuss natural and existing man-made environmental conditions that will have an impact on plans for wastewater treatment in the local area.

The Environmental Protection Agency and Leola Sewer Authority are sponsoring the meeting to get residents of the Lancaster County communities involved in the proposed project.

At the Monday night meeting, EPA will be presenting information gathered in an environmental inventory of the area since the first meeting in July. This data will be included in its Environmental Impact Statement on the project.

Concurrently, the Leola Sewer Authority is preparing a Wastewater Treatment Facilities Plan. Its presentation at the meeting will include data on the current population and wastewater treatment needs for the next 20 years.

The meeting will be held in the Upper Leacock War Memorial Building, 54 West Main Street, Leola, Pa., from 7:30 to 10:30 p.m.
