

Alfalfa weed control tips

GEORGETOWN, Del --It's time to implement weed control in alfalfa, says Delaware extension crops specialist Frank Webb. The control of competitive winter annuals such as chickweed, henbit, and mustard is important for both new and establised stands.

Several materials are available for this use, but the selection wil depend on the weed species present and whether you have a pure aifalfa stand or an alfalfa

grass mixture. For chickweed problems

in straight alfalfa stands, Furloe (also known as Chloro-IPC or CIPC) can be used

If common mustard, yellow rocket, wild turnip or peppergrass is a problem in straight alfalfa, 2,4-D-B is an excellent material to use However, air temperatures must be 50 degrees F or higher for several days after application for this material to be effective.

excellent-Another chemical for fall weed control in both new and established stands in Kerb. It has a wide spectrum of control, but its selectivity varies with the soil type and application rate



For established stands only, Sinbar and Sencor or Lexone are good








