Broiler placements up 20%

HARRISBURG — Placements of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending November 8 were 2,015,000, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service

The placements were 20 percent above the corresponding week a year earlier, but 13 percent below the previous week. Average placements during the past nine weeks were 16 percent above a year earlier.

Placements in the 21 key poultry producing states were 64,043,000, 13 percent below the previous week, but four percent above the same week a year earlier. Average placements during the past nine weeks were six percent above a year ago.

Broiler-fryers slaughtered in Pennsylvania under federal inspection during the week ending Oct. 29 totaled 1,817,000, with an average liveweight of 4.04 pounds.
