HARRISBURG Placements of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending November 8 were 2,015,000, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service

The placements were 20 percent above the corresponding week a year earlier, but 13 percent below the previous week Average placements during the past nine weeks were 16 percent above a year earlier

Placements in the 21 key poultry producing states were 64,043,00, 13 percent below the previous week, but four percent above the same week a vear earlier Average placements during the past nine weeks were six percent above a year ago.

prize, a \$3 award.






