

Md. team places fifth in 4-H hort judging

LINWOOD, Md — A Maryland team placed fifth in the 4-H division of judging competition sponsored recently by the National Junior Horticultural Association. This year's contest was held Nov 1 at Atlanta, Ga., during the forty-sixth annual convention of the NJHA.

Leading scorer for the Maryland team was Dennis Heltzel, 17, of Linwood, Md., who placed fourth in the individual standings.

Other members of the Maryland 4-H team were Linda Hearn, 16, of North Laurel; Patty Marvin, 17, of LaPlata, and Shawn Chandler, 17, of Hughesville.

Another Maryland team of former 4-H members placed third in the open division of the NJHA judging contest. Members of this team, in order of finish, were Emily C Hearn, 22, of North Laurel; David F. Jenkins, Jr., 21, of Mitchellville; and Patricia A Wheatley, 19, of LaPlata.

The NJHA judging competition also included an honors division for former 4-H contestants who finished

third or higher in prior years, or were members of teams which placed third or better.

Joyce L Marvin, 21, of LaPlata, placed second in this category, her sister, Linda M. Marvin, 18, finished third, and Thomas Barczewski, 19, of Pleasant Hill, was fifth.

Coaches for this year's Maryland youth horticulture judging teams were Mike Ensor of Westminster, and George S W Marvin of LaPlata Marvin's three daughters were involved in the competition.

Maryland 4-H teams have now finished fifth or better every year since 1970 in national youth horticulture judging contests. They were national champions in 1972, 1977 and 1979.
