

# Lancaster County DHIA Monthly Report

October 1980

A Guernsey cow owned by Fred Crider, R2 Nottingham, completed the highest 305 day lactation Sue produced 23,993 pounds of milk, 1085 pounds of butterfat with a 4.5 percent test

Second high lactation was completed by a Registered Holstein cow owned by Clyde W Martin, R1, East Earl. Dusty produced 32,656 pounds of milk, 1053 pounds of butterfat with a 3.2 percent in 305 days

The herd of Nelson H Wenger, R6, Manheim, had the highest daily butterfat average. This herd of 44 Registered Holstein cows averaged 49.2 pounds of milk, 2.20 pounds of butterfat with a 4.5 percent test

The herd of John Omar Stoltzfus, R2, Honey Brook, placed second. This herd of 42 Registered Holstein cows averaged

57.6 pounds of milk, 2.18 pounds of butterfat with a 3.8 percent test

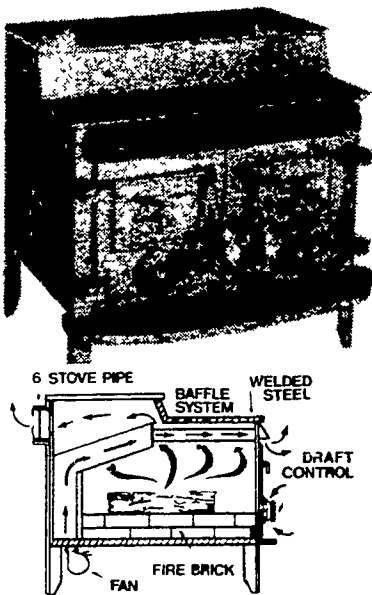
