AVONDALE — A representative of the U.S. Department of Agriculture will speak to Chester County Farmers Union members and the general public about the formation of a mushroom handling cooperative.

The meeting is slated for Wednesday, December 3 at 7:30 p.m., at the Springs Valley Inn, Avondale.

In announcing the meeting, Chester County Farmers Union president John Kimble said the USDA will send a representative from their Farmer Co-operative Service to explain and answer questions about

the feasibility of a mushroom co-operative.

"We hope a co-operative would bolster our already sagging industry in Chester County" Kimble said. "We want growers to be in attendance to offer suggestions, and to ask questions of USDA personnel."

Kimble said members will discuss mushroom marketing and bargaining as a means of helping the industry during and after the recently imposed tariff increases expire.

"The Farmers Union has worked hard to find a means of relief for the growers."

Now that a temporary relief has been granted, we must work again to find a permanent solution to battle imports."

Kimble said growers for

some time have voiced an interest in forming a co-operative. "This meeting is the first step, so it is important that every grower attend."

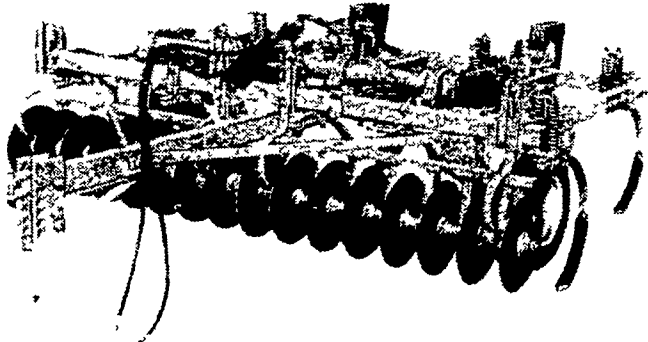
