## Some tickets available for no-till conference

LANCASTER — The Mid-Atlantic No-Till Conference draws capacity crowds of over 1000 farmers each year. The 1981 conference will be held January 8 at the Host Farm Resort, five miles west of Lancaster on U.S. Route 30.

Tickets are now available from county agricultural agents in Pennsylvania, Maryland, Delaware, New Jersey, Virginia, and West Virginia.

The program will focus on management factors affecting the future of farming. Topics to be discussed include spraying, water runoff, insect control, dry-weather stress, and new

equipment for planting and fertilizing no-tillage crops.

The morning session begins at 9:30 a.m. and includes talks on the following subjects: "Spray It Yourself;" Chinese Farming Super Till to No-Till; Tillage and Agricultural Challenges; and Managing No-Till for the Future.

The afternoon program starts at 1:30 p.m. with a talk on "Stalk Borer Control," followed by presentations on "Energy Requirements of No-Till versus Conventional Tillage," and "No-Tillage Under Stress Conditions."
