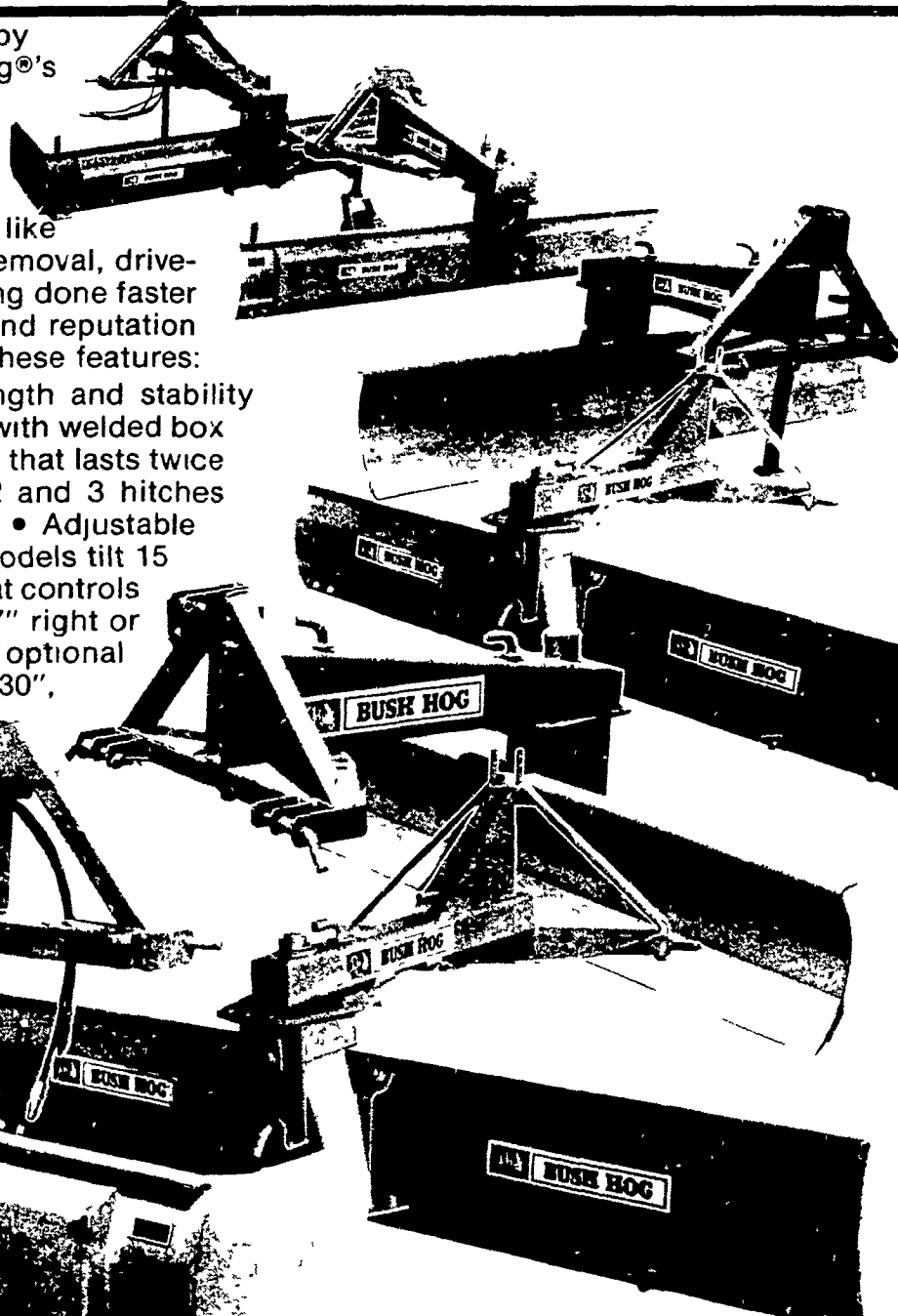
Sugar Loaf Angus Farm, Panama, Oklahoma, filled the reserve grand bull spot with reserve junior champ SL Bar Lad 9571.

LEBANON — The Cedar Crest FFA participated in the FFA County Corn Contest held November 18 at Annville-Cleona High School.

Those who participated from Cedar Crest were Bob Bomberger, 3rd in yield and 3rd in quality, Steve Wenger, 2nd in yield and 5th in quality; Mark Patches, 4th in yield and 4th in quality.

The judge for the contest was Mr David Heagy, an area seed salesman and farmer. Heagy, who judged the ten ears of corn from each entry, looked for the following characteristics: bright yellow color, uniformity of ears, straight rows, large size, freedom from mold and other marks and full ears.

Robert Kreider of Annville finished first in yield with 179 bushels per acre and Jim Rudy of Northern Lebanon was first in the quality category.
