Over the years I've attended quite a few public auctions. Thirty years ago, when we were first married, I'd go to sales because I needed something.

In those days if I had two or three dollars I could come home with a lamp, a bureau and two quaint little crocks.

Now I can go to a sale with two or three hundred dollars and come home with nothing as prices seem to be out of sight. I'm certainly glad that I bought some things a few years ago.

There is a definite knack to bidding at an auction Sometimes you can wait out an auctioneer and he will take the first bid that is offered but other times you simply lose what you really wanted Recently, I missed out on a bootjack and a doll cradle by waiting too long to place my bid

Another time an auctioneer will sell two items at some much for each and then at the last second tell the crowd that they may pick just one. By that time the article is alread; knocked down to a

customer and instead of getting just the powder flask that you wanted, someone else has it, and the two cracked chamber lids that they were selling with it or the torn comfort for which you had no use.

For the past several years, I've been doing the Sale Reports for Lancaster Farming, and so have kept in touch with the prices of many items. Most of my contacts with the auctioneers have been pleasant with just a few being unresponsive.

Some of them tell me when an article is sold they immediately forget the price while others seem able to remember outstanding prices for days.

Whether or not a sale is successful often depends on the auctioneer for he is the center of attraction. Many begin their careers at an early age and with experience gain a line of chatter so that they can convince the bidder that a purchase will be useful and wise.
