CARLISLE — Cumberland County Dairy Herd Improvement records show that 93215 cows in 147 herds were on production testing in October according to Duane G. Duncan, county agent.

Of the 123 herds on DHIA, 52 herds had an average fat production of 1.50 pounds per cow per day for the month. During the month 234 completed their 305 day lactation with 600 pounds of butterfat.

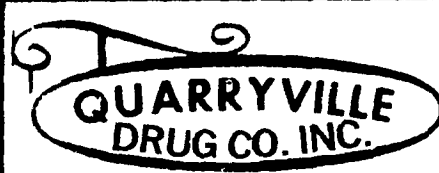
