## Broiler placements

continue up

HARRISBURG — Placements of broiler chicks in the Commonwealth during the week ending Nov 29 were 2,252,000, according to the Pennsylvania Crop Reporting Service.

The placements were three percent above the corresponding week a year earlier, and slightly above the previous week. Average placements during the past nine weeks were 16 percent above a year earlier.

Placements in the 21 key

poultry producing states were 77,315,000, three percent below the previous week but four percent above the same week a year earlier. Average placements in the 21 key states for the past nine weeks were seven percent above a year ago.

Broiler-fryers slaughtered in Pennsylvania under federal inspection during the week ending Nov. 19 totaled 1,848,000, with an average liveweight of 3.88 pounds.
