
KENNETH MASE FARM, R.D. #4, Lebanon, PA

The feeding program consists of Haylage (at 18-19% protein), Corn Silage, High Moisture corn and some baled hay. This Lebanon County dairy farmer has consistently higher production with low feed costs. This is a tour stop you will thoroughly enjoy.

Werner's herd of 121 cows average 18,100 lbs. milk and 660 lbs. B.F. Haylage, Corn Silage, High Moisture Shelled Corn and baled hay make up the feeding program. In the last year, the average milk production per cow per day for the entire herd did not go below 54.5 lbs. milk per head.
