The fed cattle trade followed an erratic pattern in reflection of a rapidly and sharply fluctuating carcass trade Prices were forced downward on the initial session, but the early decline was more than offset in an aggressive trade on later sessions as carcass prices moved substantially upward Yield grade was still a major price-determining tactor, but after Monday most buying interests were somewhat less discriminating in active competition to secure numbers The overall finish of the steer and heifer supply was still attractive with a large percentage Choice, and the volume of yield grade 4 animals was smaller somewhat Slaughter steers made up approximately 45 pct and heifers 36 pct Cows comprised 11 pct and feeders 5


