## USDA to change planting report schedule

WASHINGTON, -D.C.— The U.S. Department of Agriculture's crop reporting board will issue a modified prospective plantings report January 21, covering planned acreages of cotton, rice, corn, oats, barley, sorghum, sweet potatoes, soybeans, and peanuts in 16 states, according to Howard Hjort, USDA's director of economics policy analysis and budget.

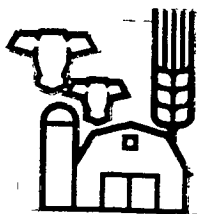
Hjort said the 16 states are Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, New Mexico, North Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Oklahoma, South Carolina and Virginia.

A second prospective plantings report for major spring planted crops for 32 states will be issued in late March, Hjort said. This report will provide early-

season indications of farmers' planting intentions and allow more time for producers to monitor markets and make production and marketing plans, he said.

Hjort said USDA will update the January report in selected areas of events suggest farmers are likely to change their earlier planting intentions.

The January and March reports will be combined to provide a national prospective plantings report in lieu of the usual April report, Hjort said.
