

# Navy bluegrass band to perform at Farm Show

HARRISBURG— Country Current, the United States Navy Band's famed country and bluegrass unit, will perform on Secretary of Agriculture's Night, January 12, at the 1981 Pennsylvania State Farm Show.

Admission to the show is free. It will begin at 7 p.m. and take place in the main arena of the Farm Show Complex.

The band specializes in music from the heartland of America and has appeared at the White House as well as at the Grand Ole Opry and the Wheeling Jamboree.

The members of Country Current are recognized for their versatility and professionalism in all aspects of country and bluegrass music.

The groups' musical direction is charted by Chief Musician Bill Emerson, who

was selected "Banjo Player of the Year" in 1972 and again in 1973 by the country and bluegrass magazine, Muleskinner News.

Leading the group in live performance is Senior Chief Musician Jerry Gilmore, the lead vocalist and master of ceremonies. Gilmore has performed on stage with such notables as Merle Haggard, Charlie Pride and Johnny Cash.

Rounding out the group are Musicians First Class Pat Verner on electric bass; Ben Winter on electric guitar; Dale Vanderpool on drums; Jeff Agnew on steel guitar and mandolin; Mike

Stein on fiddle and guitar; and Chief Musician Jim Eberhart, audio technician.

Country Current is one of seven performing units of the 170-member United States Navy Band which, since 1925, has been the premier musical representative of the Navy in our nation's capital and throughout the world.

Country Current will open

the program on Secretary of Agriculture's Night at 7 p.m. with a medley of country and bluegrass favorites. Country Current will perform again following the presentation of awards to the Farm Show Family of the Year and a Pennsylvania Agribusiness.

The program will conclude with a demonstration by the Cumberland Valley 4-H Horse and Pony Club.

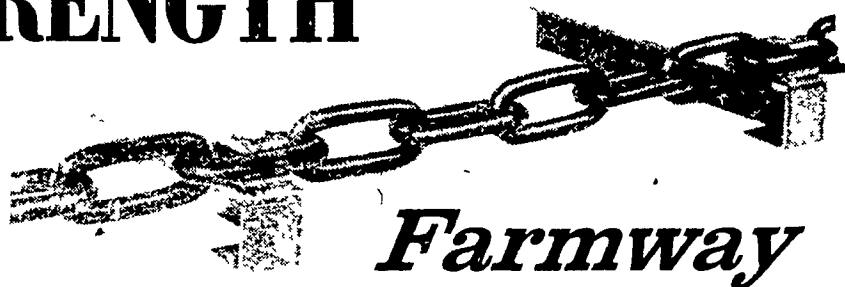

The Liquid elevator runs independent of the gutter mechanism, nine times faster, to whisk liquids and solids into the spreader.

Heavy gauge channel sections steel flights are bolted every two feet to the #67 extra heavy agricultural chain. Galvanized elevator trough is 18 1/4" wide 8" deep with continuous sanitary bottom to eliminate manure drop off.

Chain is driven about 95' per minute by 1 h.p. or 1 1/2 h.p. motor operating on 220 volts. Motor mount is adjustable. Pulley wheel has oilite bearing.

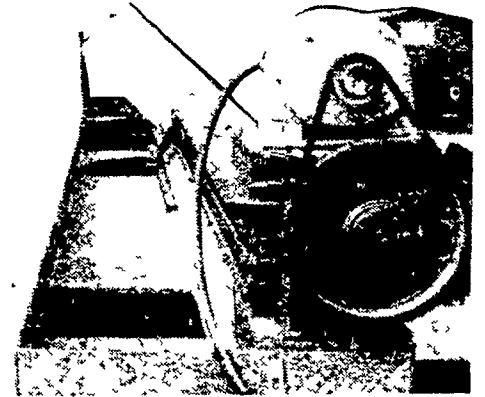
Drive mechanism of Liquid elevator is completely covered. Drive shaft also features oilite bearings.

Unique design of shuttle-stroke cleaner provides extra versatility of arrangement in barns with single or odd number gutters especially when used in combination with the chain type cleaner.

Pitman bar attached to chain of mechanical drive unit transforms rotary motion into back and forth motion. Steel bar in corner of gutter moves back and forth in eight foot strokes.

On the forward stroke, malleable iron paddles fold open across the gutter to move manure toward the spreader.

On the reverse stroke the paddles fold back against the bar to bypass and mix the manure they will carry forward on the next stroke. The push-pull action is illustrated below.
