Report supplied by USDA
Slaughter steers closed steady to 25c lower, heifers 25c to 50c higher. Cows were under pressure and closed 3 00 to 5.00 lower, bulls closed 1.00 to 2.00 lower.
Four day receipts 13,800, last week 12,600, year ago 13,650.

A liberal volume of Choice 3-4 steers and heifers continued to be marketed locally with yield grade a major price trade factor. Cow marketings increased locally. Approximately 400 fleshy 1000-1050 lbs. steers went to feeder accounts. Slaughter steers made up around 43 percent of the estimated five day total, slaughter heifers 31 percent, cows fully 17 percent and feeders 8 percent.
