Gary is the son of William and Betty Crain and has been a member of the Cumberland Valley FFA Chapter for four years.

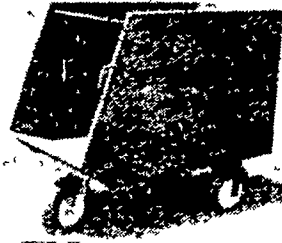

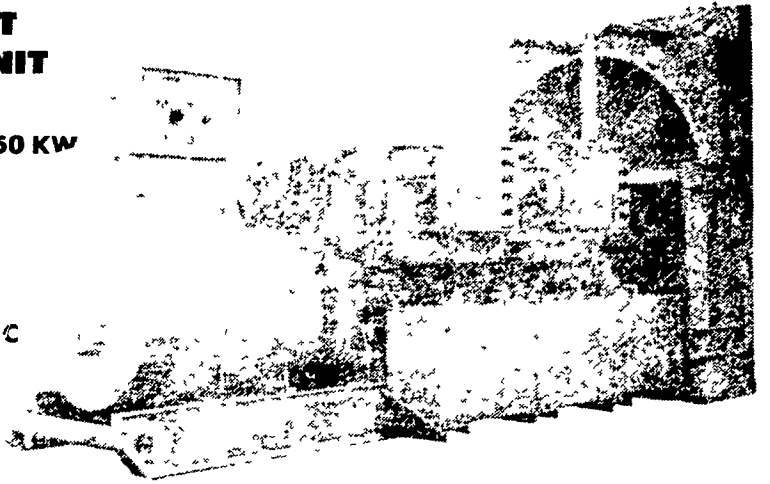

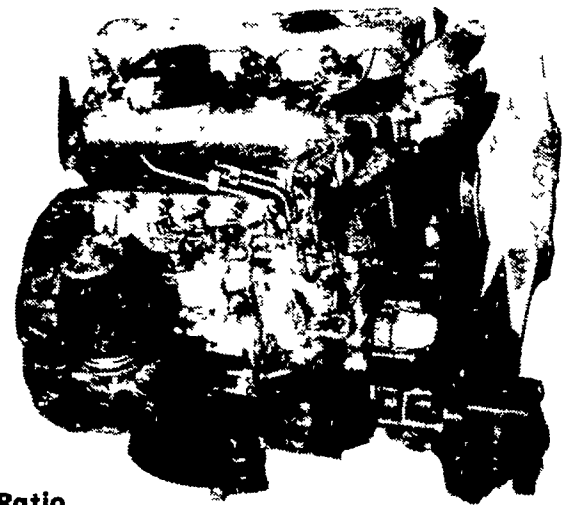
