mittee to make a report January 26 to the Executive Committee on the dairy support question

Andersen admitted that dairy production increases and the decline in demand due to the general recession will make it difficult politically for Congress to support 80 percent of parity for dairymen

In at least one other area,

But, he pointed out, the lion's share of the budget goes to food and nutrition programs including food stamps this amounts to between 65 percent and 70 percent of USDA's budget

Andersen said the Grange

Andersen said he finds the 40 percent figure difficult to swallow, but added that he could see savings of 10 percent based on the number of complaints received in Grange headquarters from people who see neighbors they believe are receiving food stamps unlawfully

Among possible changes Andersen sees is a switch in eligibility requirements. But, he conceded, there will be a percentage of fraud in any giveaway program

In general, the Grange is happy with Reagan's choice for Secretary of Agriculture

The people in Illinois are happy with what Block did with exports, Andersen said. They also like his land use and food production policy innovations

Block has retained the home farm, a vastly expanded hog and grain operation, and kept hold of the management reins while serving as top ag official in Illinois

He'll be in touch with agriculture, Andersen concluded on a positive note

We are looking forward to working with the new Administration on solving the problems facing us, he added

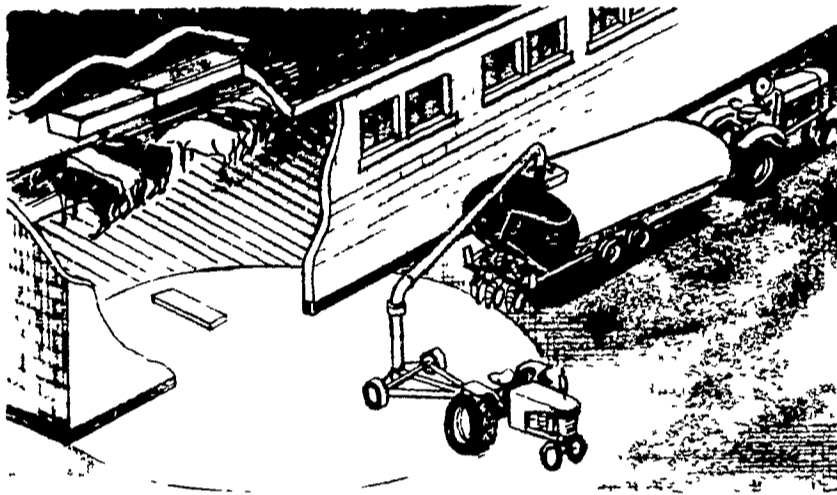

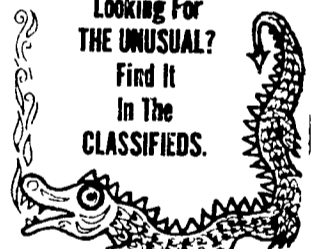
