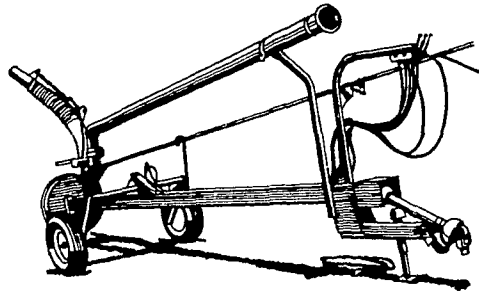

His duties as President will take him around the state discussing the implement business with all dealers. Assistance on all levels that affect businessmen will be of primary importance.

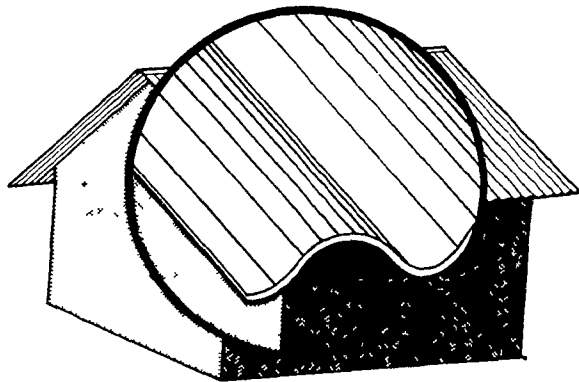

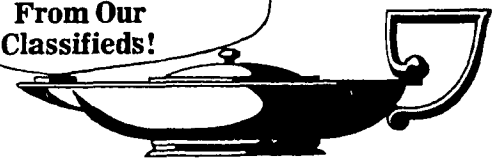

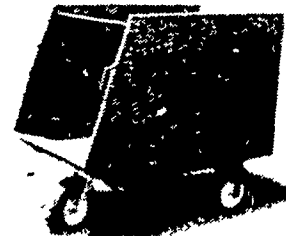
