HARRISBURG — "What are hazardous wastes and who produces them?"

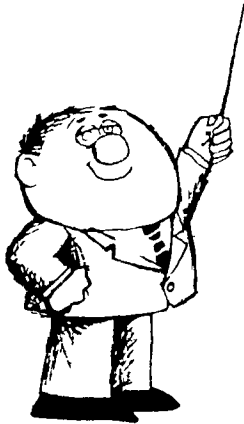
"How much hazardous waste does Pennsylvania produce and do we receive wastes from out of state?"

Availability of the free six-page pamphlet was announced today by DER Secretary Clifford L. Jones, who called disposal of toxic and hazardous wastes Pennsylvania's most serious problem when he assumed his post in early 1979.

Jones said the pamphlet is the first in a series of publications planned by DER to help the public understand the state's new comprehensive solid waste management program.
