

Order 2 dairies to pay \$13.44 for December

NEW YORK, N.Y., January 14 — Dairy farmers supplying milk plants regulated under the New York - New Jersey marketing orders during December will be paid on the basis of a uniform price of \$13.44 per hundredweight or 28.9 cents per quart.

Market Administrator Thomas A. Wilson also stated the uniform farm price per hundredweight was \$13.54 in November 1980 and \$12.25 in December 1979. The average of the monthly uniform prices for 1980 was \$12.64 per hundredweight.

The uniform price is a marketwide weighted average of the value of farm

milk used for fluid and manufactured dairy products.

The total amount of milk received from the 17,475 dairy farmers supplying the New York-New Jersey Marketing Area was 867,308,632 pounds during December 1980. This was almost 43.0 million pounds above last year. The gross value to dairy farmers for milk deliveries was \$120,167,034.52.

Wilson explained this included differentials required to be paid to dairy farmers but not voluntary premiums or deductions authorized by the farmer

Regulated milk dealers (handlers) utilized 398,206,658 pounds of milk for Class I, 45.9 percent of the total Class I milk is used for fluid milk products such as homogenized, flavored, low test and skim milks.

For December 1980,

handlers paid \$14.67 per hundredweight, or 31.5 cents per quart, for the milk used in Class I products compared with \$13.50 a year ago.

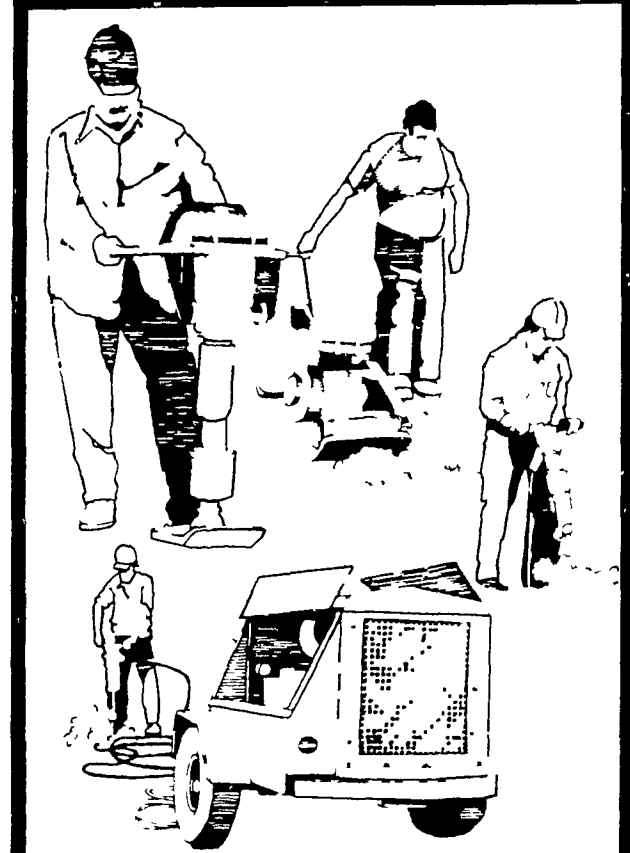
The balance of the milk, 54.1 percent, was used to manufacture Class II products including butter,

cheese, ice cream and yogurt. For this milk the handlers paid \$12.67 per hundredweight.

The uniform price is based on milk containing 3.5 percent butterfat. For December 1980, a differential of 17.0 cents was

applied to the price for each one-tenth of one percent that the milk tested above or below the 3.5 percent standard.

All prices quoted are for bulk tank milk received within the 201 to 210 mile zone from New York City.

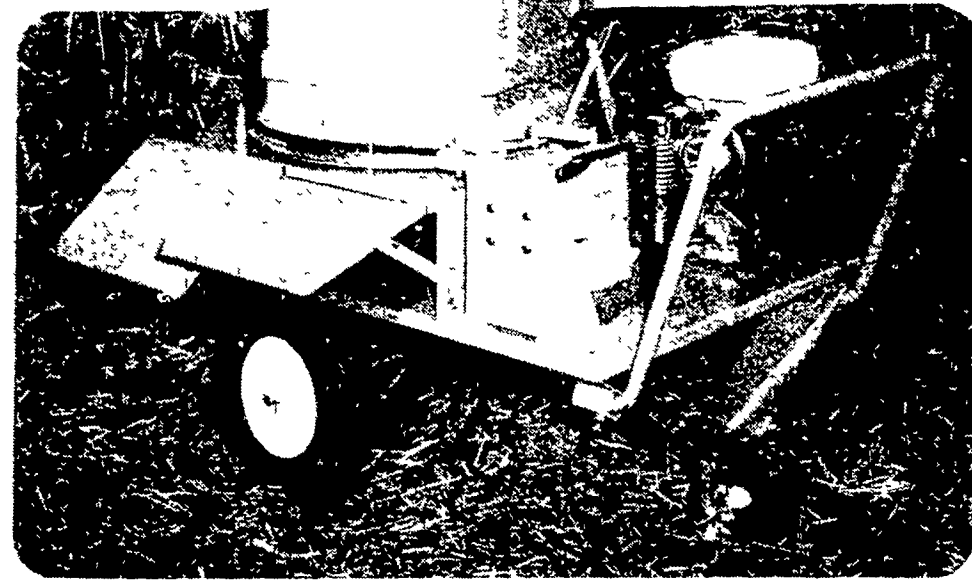

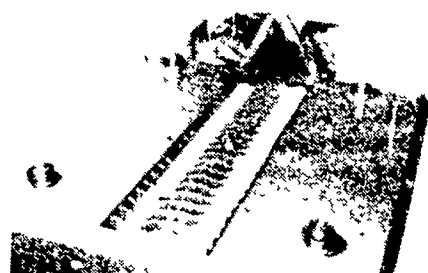

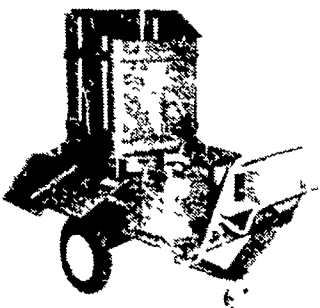
All models of Wic's bedding chopper have four rows of knives insuring a better spreading action.
