Tax cut advice for forest owners

UNIVERSITY PARK — Understanding some rather specific and complex laws can reduce total tax liability for the forest landowner, says James C. Finley, Extension forest resources specialist at Penn State.

Many owners misunderstand their tax liability, perhaps paying more than is necessary, he says.

Finley offers several sources of assistance on the subject for forest landowners on the Internal

Revenue Service.

"The IRS maintains a nation-wide toll-free telephone network through which you can receive assistance from IRS agents. Ask your telephone operator for the WATS number serving your district.

"Forestry consultants usually are quite familiar with the tax codes relating to timber sales and can be quite helpful. Their fees may be deductible. In addition,

your county Extension office can help you find local sources of expertise.

"Finally, the U.S. Forest Service has published a booklet, with the assistance of IRS, entitled "The Timber Owner and His Federal Income Tax, Agricultural Handbook 274." It is available from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402.

Milk hikes of 10% forecast

SYRACUSE — Milk prices paid to dairy farmers 1981 in the Northeast are expected to average about 10 percent higher than the record levels of 1980, according to Joseph C. Mathis, Economist for Eastern Milk Producers Cooperative. "This represents increases of about \$1.30 per hundredweight on average," he said.

Mathis stressed that, on April 1, 1981, the government support price must be adjusted to reflect increases in the prices paid for goods and services purchased by farmers (known as the parity index) since last September, as mandated by law. He said that an increase of about 7 percent, to \$13.70 a hundredweight is anticipated.

Unless the current law is extended, continued Mathis, the price support on October 1, 1981 will revert to 75 percent of parity. This would cause the support price to

hold at about the April 1 level. If the current 80 percent of parity floor is extended by Congress, the support price on October 1 likely would increase again by about 5 to 6 percent, according to the Economist.

These adjustments will assure that milk prices payable to dairy farmers in this region will increase by about 10 percent in 1981 over 1980 levels, even under the price depressing supply-

demand conditions expected this year.

In spite of the anticipated increases in prices paid to dairy farmers, they will not likely keep pace with inflation in the 1981 cost of production of about 14 percent, said Mathis. Hence, cash flow on dairy farms will remain tight, he said.






"Nevertheless," continued the Economist, "with good management, dairy farming in this region should remain financially sound."
