(1) plan ahead, (2) buy wisely, and (3) prepare carefully."

She suggests, "Plan to buy a roast and have it hot for

dinner and sliced cold for family fill up on that."

help ascourage boycotts, embargos and ill-feelings toward the food industry when food prices increase.


Hershey and her husband Arthur grow corn, hay and wheat and riase hogs. They also milk 110 registered Holsteins.
