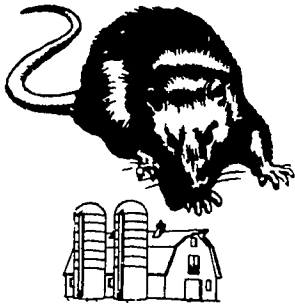

Hershey named PYFA spokesperson

COCHRANVILLE — A Chester County farm wife will be speaking out for agriculture as one of this year's state Young Farmer Spokespersons for Agriculture.

Joyce Hershey of Cochransville, represented Pennsylvania in the National Young Farmer Spokesperson for Agriculture Contest during the National Young Farmer Educational Institute in Omaha, Nebraska, in December.

In her speech on how to stretch the food dollar, Hershey said, "If we want to save money on our food bill, we need to analyze our buying habits; habits brought about by massive advertising and television. Many of the things I have found can benefit all of today's homemakers interested in good nutrition for their families at a reasonable price. To get the most from our food dollar we need to: (1) plan ahead, (2) buy wisely, and (3) prepare carefully."

She suggests, "Plan to buy a roast and have it hot for

dinner and sliced cold for lunches during the week, this would also be more nutritional than the usual lunchmeat. We have to plan. Plan to serve approximately a three-ounce serving per person; don't display the whole roast and have the

family fill up on that."

The spokesperson program in which Hershey participated is sponsored by Elanco Products Company to help consumers better understand the American farmer and food prices. The purpose of the program is to

help discourage boycotts, embargos and ill-feelings toward the food industry when food prices increase.

Hershey and her husband Arthur grow corn, hay and wheat and raise hogs. They also milk 110 registered Holsteins.
