

Ephrata Young Farmers elect 1981 officers

EPHRATA — The Ephrata Area Young Farmers Association Tuesday night elected Gerald B Martin as president for 1981.

In addition, the group elected other officers and made final plans for their 12th annual banquet.

Martin, R1 Ephrata, is a dairyman with 48 registered Holsteins. He farms 120 acres.

The meeting will be held at the Durlach-Mt Airy Fire Hall and will feature Ken Hussar, a humorous speaker and entertainer.

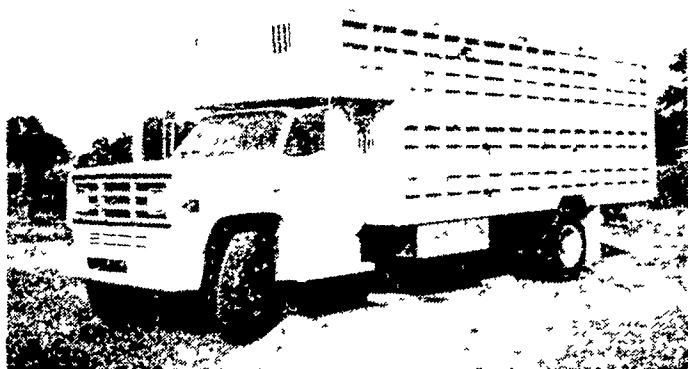
In addition the group will present its poultry, beef, hog, dairy and crops awards and will hold formal installation of the new officers listed above.

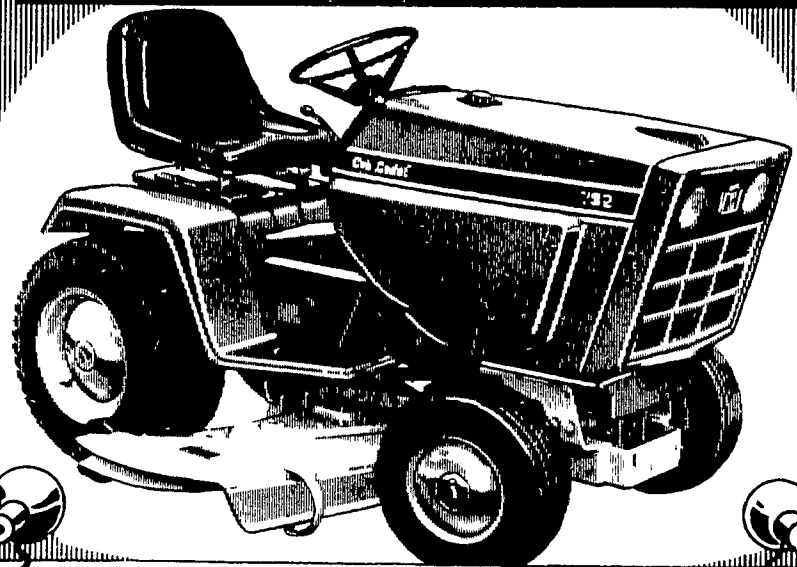
