

Heather Staubach wears Pa. Apple Queen crown

HERSHEY — As of Tuesday evening, Heather Lee Staubach of York County is wearing the Pennsylvania Apple Queen crown. She was crowned during the 122nd Annual Meeting of the State Horticultural Association of Pennsylvania, Inc. meeting here

this week.

The Penn State sophomore proudly wears her tiara high atop her dark brown hair — the new queen's height is one inch over six feet tall. She received the crown from last year's queen Kris Shutt from Adams County.

As tears brimmed in her brown

eyes, Heather proclaimed her surprise at being selected to represent the state's apple industry.

"I gave it my best, and I won," she said.

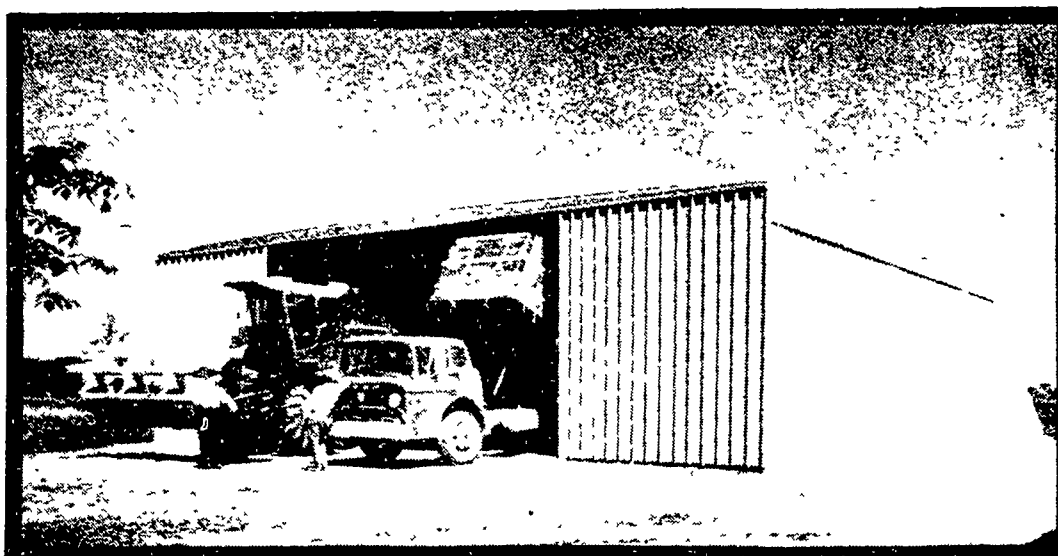

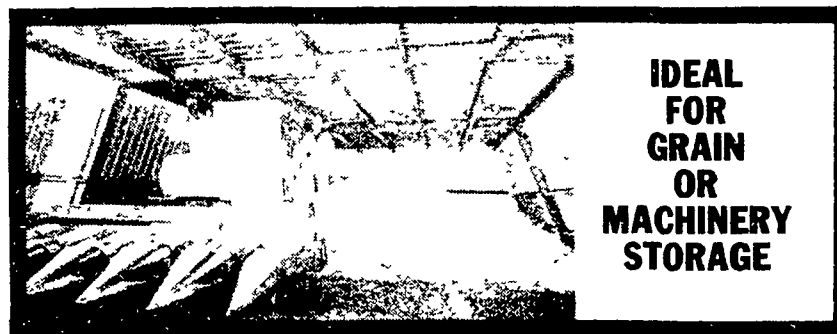
