

Dairy-livestock day to run March 2

UNIVERSITY PARK — Dairy and livestock producers will have "their day" March 2 at Penn State

College of Agriculture staff members will host the first combined Dairy and Livestock Day, to be held in the J.O. Keller Conference Center at University Park.

Registration is set for 9 a.m. March 2 with the program beginning at 9:30.

Dairy and Livestock Day features recent research findings at Penn State, according to the conference co-chairman, Lowell L. Wilson. The event also gives farmers, scientists, and extension specialists an opportunity to discuss the results, he added.

This will be the first time for a combined Dairy and Livestock Day at Penn State, it

was pointed out. Previously, these biennial events were held as separate dairy and livestock days.

The morning's general session March 2 will include two nationally prominent authorities on livestock production and energy: Robert H. Rumler, Executive Chairman of the Holstein Association of America, Brattleboro, VT, will discuss "Challenges and Opportunities in Animal Agriculture in the 80's."

Rodney O. Martin, Director of Farm Systems Research and Development for Agway, Inc., of Syracuse, NY, will describe "Alternative Energy Sources and Energy Conservation in the 80's."

Afternoon topics will be divided into dairy, beef cattle, sheep, and swine sections. Up-to-

date reports will describe research and demonstration projects carried out within the Department of Dairy and Animal Science.

The annual Cattlemen's Banquet March 2 will feature an address by W.T. "Dub" Berry, Jr., Executive Vice President of the National Cattlemen's Association. Berry's topic will be "Financing and Marketing in the 1980's."

The 7 p.m. banquet at Gatsbys, State College, requires a \$12 pre-registration by February 26.

The banquet fee should be mailed to 410 J.O. Keller Conference Center, University Park, PA 16802. Make checks payable to the Pennsylvania State University and indicate for Cattlemen's Banquet.
