Soils and seeding workshop scheduled Feb. 24

LANCASTER — The Board of Directors of the Lancaster County Conservation District are sponsoring a workshop for engineers, architects, surveyors, developers, realtors, contractors, municipal officials, and any other interested parties

The workshop will cover soils, seeding and a look at their relationship to erosion and sedimentation control. In addition, low hazard site planning, the Land and Water Resource Study, filter fabric, and Act 287 will be discussed

The workshop will be held on February 24, 1981 between 8 30 a.m. and 3 30 p.m. in the auditorium of the Farm and Home Center, 1383 Arcadia Road, Lancaster

The workshop will familiarize

the participant with a basic understanding of soils and how to use the soil survey. The participants also will learn about the needs for seeding and how to get it done the cheapest, easiest, and most effective way. Well established vegetation is one of the cheapest and most effective erosion control measure.

The cost of the workshop is \$10 per person which includes a buffet luncheon, coffee break, and handout materials. Preregistration is mandatory before February 19.
