

## Dauphin 4-H Beef members earn awards

HARRISBURG — The Dauphin County 4-H Beef Clubs held their annual awards banquet Saturday evening at Susquehanna Township High School. Over 300 4-H'ers, parents, sponsors, and advisors turned out for the trophy presentations.

Kaye Sweigard, Halifax, was recognized for showing the champion Roundup steer in Dauphin County. Kaye serves as president of the Upper Dauphin 4-H Baby Beef Club. She also received a show halter award for her reserve champion Angus heifer.

From the Lower Dauphin Baby Beef Club, Dwayne Messick, Elizabethtown, took home a trophy for his reserve champion Roundup steer and one for his champion Chianina heifer. Dwayne had the high project for the club south of the Blue Mountain.

The high project for the Upper Dauphin club went to Steve Martz, Millersburg.

Becky Webster, Halifax, Garth Sweigard, Halifax, and Sally Messick, Elizabethtown, received trophies for their lightweight, light mediumweight, and heavyweight

Roundup champs, respectively. Sally also earned a trophy with her reserve champion Simmental heifer.

Two more Messicks, Mike and Joe, received trophies for their heifer projects, too. Mike had the champion Simmental heifer, while Joe showed the reserve champion Chianina heifer.

The Lower Dauphin club's president, Rick Baker, was recognized as the top Senior showman. His steer was the best gaining project animal in the club.

The best gaining steer in the Upper Dauphin club was Monique Sweigard's Chianina x Angus crossbred. Monique was also selected as the top Intermediate showman, and earned a trophy for her champion Angus heifer.

Tim Foreman, Hershey, was the top Junior showman. The clubs also recognized his special achievement at the Southeast District Show, where he was chosen top showman in his age bracket.

And, the trophy for showing the top-placing steer at Farm Show went to Doug Deppen, Halifax.
