Bank sets special ag loan rate

During 1980 the national prime rate of interest peaked at 20 percent, dropped quickly and then topped 20 percent again late in the

The new agricultural prime rate will be charged on all variable rate borrowings to American Bank customers who are individuals or companies engaged in agricultural production The rate does not apply to farm related enterprises


