

Relief sale to be held Thursday

LANCASTER — A planned Thursday at the benefit relief sale Guernsey Sales Barn, Lincoln Highway East, will feature more than 80 head of dairy livestock.

The sale will open at 10 a.m. with hay, straw, grain, farm equipment and supplies, including seven yards of concrete. Sale of the dairy animals is scheduled at 11.30 a.m.

"This marks the first year that we will be selling livestock," John Umble, R1 Atglen, member of the sale's planning committee, said.

"We've had an excellent response and a lot of good animals have been donated for the sale."

The donated livestock includes 20 bred heifers, 20 open yearlings, 40 heifer calves of all ages and three bulls about seven months old.

Livestock and other items have been donated from a six-county area, including Lancaster, Chester, Berks, Bucks, York and Cumberland Counties.

In addition to Umble, Leon Kurtz, of Cochranville, and Robert Kauffman, of Elizabethtown, will serve as auctioneers.

As with the Harrisburg Relief Sale, which is scheduled on April 4, proceeds from the local sale will be distributed among relief purposes by the Mennonite Central Committee.

This marks the third year the local sale has been held to give area residents an opportunity to donate items for relief. At the two previous sales, held at the New Holland Sales Stables, sale items were confined to hay, straw, grain, and farm supplies.
