

## Ag leaders to attend food policy conference

SAN FRANCISCO, Calif. - International leaders, interested in the problems of worldwide food production and distribution, are scheduled to attend a three-day conference in San Francisco, March 4 to 6, entitled "Food Security in a Hungry World."

The meeting, to be held at the St. Francis Hotel here, will be sponsored jointly by the University of California

at Davis and Castle & Cooke, Inc., a major multinational producer and marketer of food products.

The conference will mark one of the few times that private industry has joined with academia in inviting international government, industry and university representatives to discuss a subject of worldwide importance.

"The conference has been designed to

provide a multi-disciplinary forum for professionals working toward the solution of diverse problems related to world food supplies," the co-sponsors said.

"The objectives of the meeting are to analyze current issues, define future needs and develop policies and priorities for action.

"Because food is a basic human need, food policy issues present complex questions for international leaders in the 1980's. Establishing a secure food supply for future generations poses a fundamental challenge for business, government and academic leaders."

International representation will include speakers from the United Nations, Mexico, Chile, Italy, Egypt and The Netherlands. Arturo R. Tanco, Jr., president of the World Food Council and Minister of Agriculture for the Philippines, will make the concluding presentation, "Design for the Future."

U.S. speakers will include Warren W. Lebeck, consultant with the Chicago Board of Trade; Dr. Jere E. Goyan, Commissioner of the U.S. Food & Drug Administration; Dr. Barbara A. Underwood, associate professor of nutrition, Massachusetts Institute of Technology; Peter Perkins, vice president, FMC Corporation; C. Peter Tummer of the Harvard Graduate School of Business, and additional experts from the academic, business and government communities.

Attendees will include senior managers and financial executives of domestic and international food companies; government officials concerned with agricultural development and food policy issues; academic leaders in food science, technology, nutrition and agricultural economics, and news media covering all aspects of agriculture and the food industry.

Presentations and discussion will focus on such subjects as the role of governments, domestic and multinational firms, and financial institutions in shaping and implementing food policy; ways in which developing nations might balance trade-offs in the creation of effective food strategies; whether agricultural products should be used as a tool of foreign policy; and assurance of food safety and environmental quality while maintaining an adequate supply of food for the world.
