

Cost less than you think.

Dual covers more than twice as many acres as Lasso, on most soil types.

You can see for yourself on the rate chart. The Lasso¹ rate is more than double the Dual[®] rate. In almost every case.

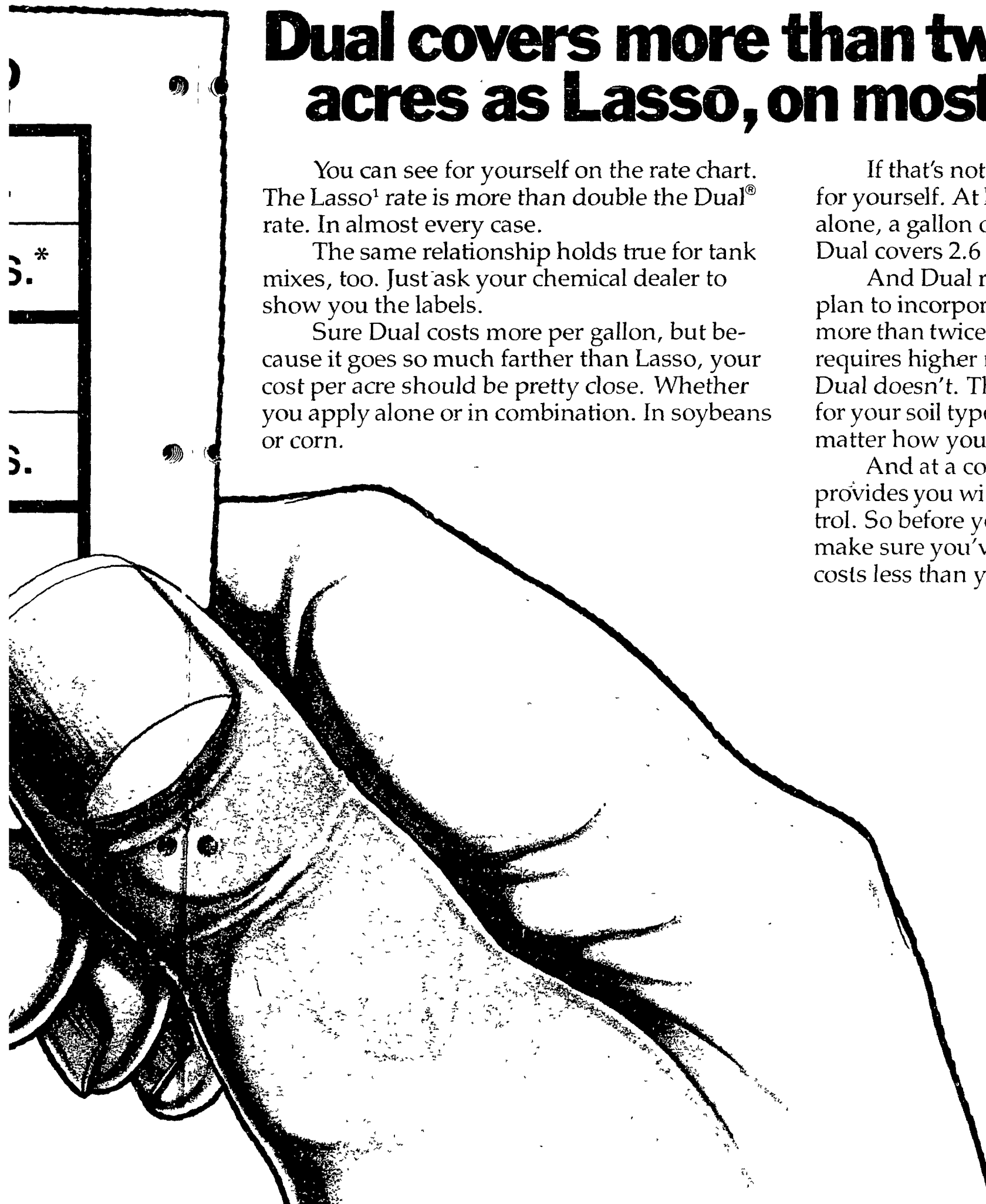
The same relationship holds true for tank mixes, too. Just ask your chemical dealer to show you the labels.

Sure Dual costs more per gallon, but because it goes so much farther than Lasso, your cost per acre should be pretty close. Whether you apply alone or in combination. In soybeans or corn.

If that's not what you've heard, compare for yourself. At labeled rates for Dual and Lasso alone, a gallon of Lasso covers only 1 to 2 acres. Dual covers 2.6 to 5.3 acres per gallon.

And Dual really has the edge when you plan to incorporate. In every case Dual covers more than twice as many acres per gallon. Lasso requires higher rates when you incorporate, Dual doesn't. The one rate of Dual established for your soil type is the only one you'll need. No matter how you apply.

And at a comparable cost per acre, Dual provides you with 2 to 4 weeks longer grass control. So before you make your final decision, make sure you've seen the bottom line. Dual costs less than you think.
