Vo-ag teachers develop energy course

Students learn how to determine if a home has adequate insulation, how to reduce use of electricity, how to caulk a home, and many other ways to conserve energy in the home and on the farm.

Entitled "Energy Conservation in the Home and on the Farm," the manual was named the outstanding publication in the eastern region in 1980 by the American Association of Teacher Educators in Agriculture

"Ideas and suggestions from teachers of vocational agriculture were used throughout the development of the manual," stated David L. Howell, in charge of the project for the Department of Agricultural Education at University Park.

"We figured that early involvement of

teachers would enable them to be very knowledgeable and interested in using the material as it was intended," Howell commented.

Cooperating on the project were personnel with the Bureau of Vocational Education in Harrisburg and the Pennsylvania Farm Electrification Council. The same high school teachers assisted the agricultural education faculty at Penn State in instructing other vocational agriculture teachers in methods of conserving energy in the home and on the farm. After completing such a course, these teachers provided instruction in conservation to home-area high school students.

The completed manual has three sections. The first deals with the need for energy conservation, showing how nonrenewable

sources of energy are being depleted at a fast rate.

The second section covers energy conservation in the home. The third section is devoted to energy conservation on the farm.

This manual is now available from the Agricultural Education Curriculum Laboratory at Penn State. Interested people outside of schools can obtain a copy by writing to the Department of Agricultural Education, 102 Armsby Building, University Park, PA 16802.

UNIVERSITY PARK — Demand is up for goats and goat producers. Penn State dairy specialists attribute the upsurge to the renewed interest in home-produced foods and the interest in organic foods

To help both the established and new dairy goat owners, Penn State's correspondence course on Dairy Goats offers feeding and breeding information with special attention given to optimum management techniques. Origin, characteristics, and adaptation of breeds of milk goats are given with general standards for size, dairy character, body capacity, strong toplines and udders, along with other evaluations for specific breeds.

Illustrations of equipment (feed racks, hay and grain feeders); plans for a milk house, milking room, and walk-through milking parlor; and blueprints of facilities for loose housing, goat and kid barn, and a buck barn are given in this nine-lesson course.
