One prime concern for cattle producers is a potential buildup of rumen acids. Cattle neutralize excess rumen acids naturally with sodium bicarbonate secreted in their saliva

But young cattle salivate less and thus have a less effective buffering natural system, notes Trenkle Feeding supplemental bicarb at 0.5 percent of dry matter helps them adapt to high grain rations earlier in the feeding period, he says.

The greatest response bicarb supplementation has been recorded in experiments where cattle were ted rapidly fermenting rations - corn silage, wheat and more exotic feeds such as potato waste.
