Trees cut fuel bills

HARRISBURG 'Don't blame high fuel bills on cold weather blame them on winter winds," says Duayne Forsberg, specialist, resource Dauphin Conservation District. 'Knock those winds out of old man winter's sails by planting trees around your home for a windbreak '

According to Forsberg, a solid row of evergreens, about 20 feet high, will slow down winds for a ground distance up to 200 feet and can lower home heating bills up to 20 percent.

Each spring the Dauphin Conservation District observes Arbor Day by conducting a tree seedling sale. These trees are three and four year old bareroot seedlings. Four species of coniferous trees averaging 12" in height and six species of deciduous trees averaging 20" in height are available.

Forsberg elaborated on the species for sale. They are Douglas fir. blue spruce, white pine, Norway spruce, red oak, white flowering dogwood, black walnut, Russian olive and scarlet maple.

Individuals interested in purchasing trees can call the Conservation District's 24 hour 'evergreen'' line at 652-7073 or write to the Dauphin County Conservation District, 75 S. Houcks Road, Suite 305. Harrisburg, PA 17109 to request an order form with prices and tree information The deadline to order trees is April 6.

Trees will be available for pick-up on Saturday, April 25, between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m. Pick-up locations will be Colonial Park Plaza, U.S. Rt. 22 and Colonial Road, and Lvkens Valley Plaza in Elizabethville.
