Relief sale totals \$77,181

LANCASTER — A total of \$77,181 was raised in the relief sale of dairy livestock and farm merchandise at the Guernsey Sales Barn on Thursday, March 5.

The sale included 80 head of dairy animals, hay, straw and other farming equipment and items.

Average selling price of the dairy livestock was \$925. Top selling animal was a bred

heifer from the herd of Nelson Wenger, Manheim, which sold for \$2500. Four animals topped \$2000 in price.

There was an excellent response to the sale on the part of both donors and purchasers, according to John Umble, one of the sale organizers.
