



# Bangor pullers among Expo winners

A pair of seconds were taken in the 13,000-lb. and 15,000-lb. stock classes by Robert Kiefer, of R4, Bangor.

Competition got underway on Thursday with a full pull in the 5500-lb. class by Richard Troxell,

of R1, Andreas, with his Ford 6000. In the 7500-lb. class Ralph Wolverton, R1, Asbury, N.J., coaxed his Deere 4010 to a winning pull of 174 feet, nine inches.

Barry Ott's top pull in the 9000lb. class with his AC 200 was 161

The top 11,000-lb pull by Albert Kiefer in his Ford 9600 was 167 feet, four inches.

David H. Gross, R1, Hamburg, took the 13,000-lb. stock class with a full pull by his Deere 4230.

In the 15,000-lb. stock class the top pull by Larry Klinger, of R1, Selinsgrove, totaled 155 feet, seven inches with an Oliver 1850T.
