## Volunteers needed for parasite program

DOVER, Del. — The Delaware  
Department of Agriculture, in  
cooperation with the Delaware  
Extension Service, is sponsoring a  
parasite release demonstration  
this summer. The program will use  
Pediobius, a parasitic wasp, to  
control Mexican bean beetles in  
soybeans.

This control method has been  
used effectively in Delaware for a  
number of years now.
