With all the ads and articles advertising new merchandise, from combines to comic books, that are printed in Lancaster Farming every week, it would take a full-time private investigator to check out all the claims made to: products in order to make sure everything that s said is true

However, we do not knowingly publish intormation which is traudulant or misleading.

Consumers across the U.S. have come to find, unfortunately, that not all the claims of companies are true For this reason, there is an agency called the Better Business Bureau working to protect the citizens of this country from deceipt in business

I never had reason to contact this

letter from a Lancaster Farming subsriber prompted my call

George Plut of Happiness Hills Farms, R3 Addison, New York 14801 was not happy with his expersence in ordering a book he read about in our newspaper. He writes

I am enclosing a write up you had about your 'Farm Estate in which you had mentioned the price and he \$1745 plus a dollar postage. And you gave the auth that it should be sent to.

I have sent them the money, to the listed address, and have never received the material. I wrote them again on September 4 asking for it and again on December 17, and again on February 10. to date I have received no response.

Perhaps you might be able to check on this as perhaps it has also affected some of the other people who might have written

upstliv learn you had not received any satisfaction on ordering the book, Your Farm Estate by James N Wilson, after reading about it in our paper

I d like to point out, nowever, the book has no attiliation with our paper - we merely received a news release announcing it could be purchased from Creative Financial Planning, Suite 234, 8060 Knue Road, Indianapolis, IN 46250

After I read your letter, I decided to contact the company and ask them about the book. On telephoning directory assistance to ask the number of Creative

Financial Planning, I was told by an Indiana 317 Area Code Operator there was no such listing under that name in Indianapolis

This left a question mark floating before my eyes, so I decided to check with the Better Business Bureau office in Lancaster. The voice on the other end of the telephone connection informed me she had no record of Creative Financial Planning in her files and referred me to the Indianapolis office of BBB.

Atter several attempts of breaking through a busy signal, I finally heard the welcomed ring indicating my call was going through Unfortunately, the person that anwered was a machine telling me all the lines were busy — try again later

Just when I was about ready to give up, I finally got past the recording to a welcomed human voice announcing I had reached the Better Business Bureau office ın İndianapolis

Hurray - I almost hugged the receiver (tunny how little delays can bring so much anticipation) Quickly gaining my composure, I asked the BBB person it she had any record of the company in question

Then the inevitable - I was asked if I could hold on. With pencil rapping an impatient cadence on my desk top covered with notes of telephone numbers, I bit my np and waited - ready for the runaround scam

But, to my surprise, the BBB spokesperson said she did have record of Creative Financial Planning - but their address had changed

She informed me the company's new address is 4352 E 82nd Street. Suite A. Indianapolis, IN 46250

You might try writing that address, Mr. Plitt, and see it you get any satisfaction It you remain unsuccessful in either getting your book or your money back, report this to the Better Business Bureau in Indianapolis by calling 317/923-1593

if you still have no luck, report the incident to your local post master since this may constitute mail traud — a federal offense


