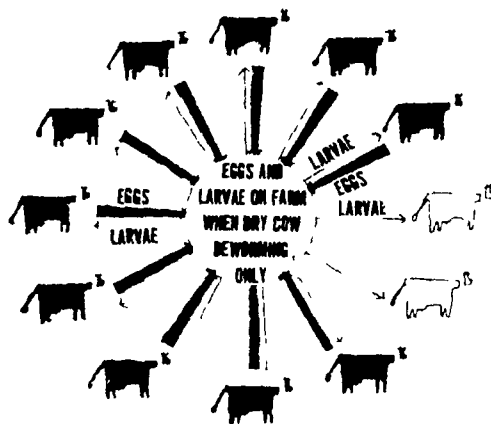
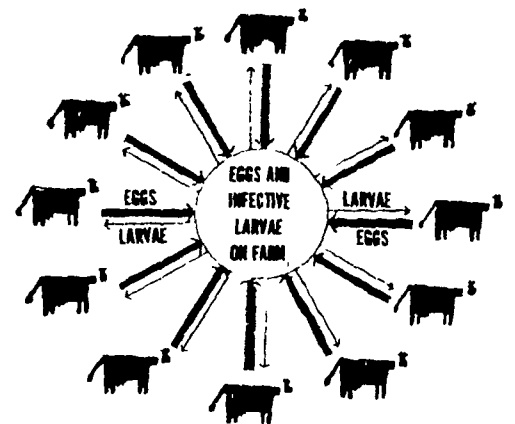

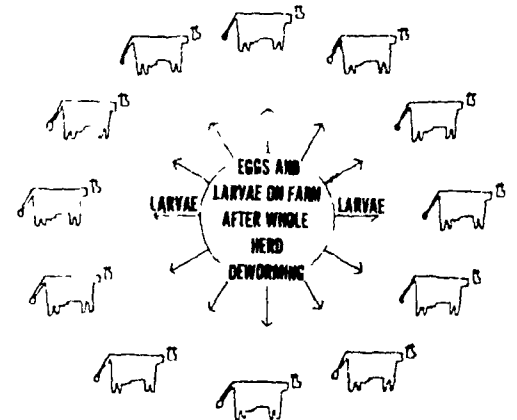
#### THE LOGIC BEHIND WHOLE HERD DEWORMING
