Order 4 dairy asks suspension

PHILADELPHIA — Herbert L. Forest, dairy official with the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Marketing Service, said a proposal to suspend from March through August 1981 the limit on the type of pool plant eligible for automatic pool status during that period, is under consideration in the Middle Atlantic area.

Forest said the suspension was requested by Michaels Dairies, Inc., a distributing plant regulated under the order.

Michaels contends that producers supplying its plant are threatened with loss of pooling

status under the order because it has lost Class I sales to another handler in the market.

As a result, Michaels says it may not be able to continue meeting the pooling requirements of the order.

Federal milk marketing orders set the minimum price regulated handlers must pay dairy farmers for their milk. The orders do not set the price consumers pay for milk or dairy products at retail outlets.

The suspension notice was published in the March 9 Federal Register, available at most public libraries.

100 grams of protein in the powdered whey shows 18.03 percent glutamic acid, 10.95 percent aspartic acid, 10.5 percent leucine and 8.69 percent lysine.

Other amino acids in the protein are: threonine, 4.84 percent; serine, 4.96 percent; proline, 6.24 percent; glycine, 2.09 percent; alanine, 4.87 percent; valine, 5.29 percent; half-cystine, 1.68 percent; amide N, 2.14 percent; methionine, 2.40 percent; isoleucine, 5.29 percent; tyrosine, 3.28 percent; phenylalanine, 3.72 percent; histidine, 1.99 percent; and arginine, 3.07 percent.

In addition to selling the powdered whey as an animal feed supplement (100-pound bags sell for approximately \$40 depending on fat content and type of fat which can be tailored to customer specifications), Schanback is currently experimenting with possible other uses for his unique product.

One likely prospect? "Cake mixes. Because the whey is immediately soluble and high in oil content, you could feasibly include it in baking mixes, so the consumer wouldn't have to add any oil."

After cattle and cakes, one begins to wonder where Schanback will next think of marketing this singular product. Caramel wheyfers?
